2. Principal's Report to PAC April 27, 2022

- April 25th was a Professional Development Day. Many staff joined an online workshop discussing Universal Designs for Learning.
- The **mid-semester report for semester 2** will be published on the MyEducation family portal by 3:00 pm on April 29th
- Online scheduling for **Parent-Teacher conferences** opens at 5:00 pm on April 28th and closes at 3:00 pm on May 3rd.
- Parent-Teacher conferences will be online using Teams from 4:00 -7:00 pm on May 5th.
- Numeracy and Literacy assessments are taking place again the week of April 26-29 for students in semester 2. Grade 10 students are writing both a literacy and a numeracy assessment while Grade 12 students are writing a literacy assessment. These assessments determine a student's proficiency on a scale of 1-4 and are a graduation requirement.
- Killarney has been selected to **participate in the PISA** Assessment (Programme for International Student Assessment). This is a world-wide assessment that assesses student ability in Mathematics, Reading, and Science. 53 of our Grade 10 students were selected randomly. This assessment will be completed on May 12th and 16th.
- Congratulations to **Konnor Mclean from our Yearbook class**. His yearbook cover design finished first out of 1,000 schools across North America!
- The Senior and Honours Strings classes are putting on a **concert on Friday, April 29**th at 7:30 pm in the auditorium. Admission by donation. Come support the students and the Strings program and enjoy some wonderful music!
- Our **enrollment for next year** is projected around 1550, which is up slightly from the 1525 we had this year.
- The school's **school leaving ceremony** is confirmed for June 9th at 7:00 pm in the Orpheum. Two tickets are included for each student. Additional tickets can be purchased through School Cash online.
- **Prom** (dinner and dance) at the Pan Pacific is confirmed for June 22nd. Details to follow.
- Weir elementary classes (5 divisions for grades 5-7) are expected to continue at Killarney in the Fall of next year. Weir's seismically upgraded school is expected to be finished sometime between September 2022 and January 2023.
- The school will be practicing its **earthquake evacuation drill** on May 11th.
- **Summer School Registration** will open May 9th and close June 10th. Review (grades 8 & 9), remedial (grades 10 & 11), preview (grades 8 & 9), ELL (grades 8-12), and completion (grades 10-12) courses will be available at 4 sites—John Oliver, Churchill, Van Tech, and Point Grey.
