#### 2. Principal's Report to PAC February 22, 2022

- Students have settled into their semester 2 classes with semester 2 starting Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- On the Covid-19 front, I want to remind parents to ensure that the Daily Health Assessment for your child is done prior to sending your student to school. **Students who have symptoms** should follow the provincial health guidelines and stay home and self-isolate if they are sick as they risk making others unwell. Students who develop symptoms at school will be asked to go home.
- Ministry of Health will be providing a box of 5 rapid tests for each student. Once we receive the shipment we will be distributing them to students.
- As we enter the new calendar year, **planning for the next school year**, **2022-23**, intensifies. Our school-based team, consisting of next year's grade 8 counsellor and our school-based resource teacher, have been **meeting with our feeder elementary schools** to discuss grade 7 students who will be coming to Killarney in September.
- A reminder that students should have their course choices inputted for the next school year by this Friday, February 25th at noon in their My Education account. Each student should have 8 course choices (Grade 12's may choose 7 as a minimum) with two alternatives in case they don't get their first-choice electives.
- The **Semester 1 final report card** was published February 9<sup>th</sup>.
- **UBC student teachers started their long practicums** here on Feb. 22nd. We have 2 teacher-candidates in Mathematics, 2 in Fine Arts, 1 in English-ELL, and 1 in Business Education.
- Cross-boundary applications accepted from February 1-28. The District sets the number of cross-boundary students (coming into grade 8) that the school can accept—last year it was 25. Also, the District ranks the applicants and we are required to take the top 25 on their list which is based on priority categories like siblings, in-district and out of catchment, and out of district.
- February 18<sup>th</sup> was a **District Professional Development Day**. Students enjoyed a 4-day weekend as Feb. 21<sup>st</sup> was the Family Day holiday.
- **Pink shirt** day was today, February 23rd. Students asked to wear pink in support of anti-bullying.
- Mini School first offers for the September 2022 grade 8 class were sent out today with acceptances due by noon on Feb. 25<sup>th</sup>. If needed, second offers will go out March 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- **Killarney Theatre** will be presenting their main stage production, **The Seussification of Romeo** and **Juliet**, for 4 nights on March 7-10<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm in the auditorium. Tickets are \$12. A live audience is now possible with the District allowing up to 50% capacity for performances.
- Last day of classes before Spring Break will be Friday, March 11<sup>th</sup>. Spring Break is from March 14-25 with school reopening on Monday, March 28<sup>th</sup>.
