- 2. **Principal's Report** Kal Gill
 - Happy New Year to all the parents and students!
 - Semester 1 ends January 28th with January 31st being a semester turnaround day. On this day classes will not be scheduled but students are able to come to school to finish off and submit work as needed. Semester 2 starts on February 1st. Most students will start 4 new courses which will meet every day until the end of the year.
 - On the **Covid-19 front**, I want to remind parents to ensure that the **Daily Health Assessment** for your child is done prior to sending your student to school. Students who have symptoms should follow the provincial health guidelines, stay home, and self-isolate if they are sick as they risk making others unwell. Students who develop symptoms at school will be asked to go home.
 - My letter of January 7th did explain the term **functional closure** (temporary closure due to a shortage of staff). In this case, the school would pivot to online learning on TEAMS. So far, we have had no issues in covering staff absences (without a TTOC or EOC) internally.
 - As we enter the new calendar year, **planning for the next school year**, 2022-23, intensifies.
 - Grade 7 Parent Information Night video posted on the school website later in January. In this video Mr. Myring and Ms. Romano highlight the grade 8 program and review the articulation process for the current grade 7's looking to attend Killarney in September.
 - **Mini school applications** have come in and are being processed. The application, in conjunction with results of the school assessment and previous report card data, will be used to determine the 30 successful applicants for the program.
 - Students in **grades 8-11 will be doing course planning for next year in February**. Grade counsellors will be leading them through this process through the grade-wide TEAMS online platform. Each grade counsellor has created a course planning video for students. There are also instructions on how to select courses in MyEd.
 - In support of the course planning process, Departments have created course information videos found on the Guidance and Support > Course Planning tab on the school website.
 - Our articulation process with our feeder elementary schools has begun. We hosted an online meeting for grade 7 teachers and administrators on January 18th. Registration forms for our catchment students are due back to Killarney by Feb. 9th. We are currently booking online meetings with our feeder schools by our school-based team for February. The team consists of next year's grade 8 counsellor, Ms. Romano and school-based resource teacher Ms. Noble. The purpose of the meetings is to have a discussion about the grade 7's who will be coming to Killarney in September with the focus of how to best meet their learning needs.
 - The semester 2 final report card will be published February 9th by 3:00 pm on the MyEd family portal.
 - **UBC** student teachers start their practicums here on Feb. 22nd.
 - **Cross-boundary applications** accepted from February 1-28.
 - February 18th will be a **District Professional Development Day**. School will not be in session for students.
