#### **2. KPAC Finance Report**

- GAMING ACCOUNT
- Sep 28th Balance \$5,523.85
- Gaming Funds Deposit \$30,960
- Oct 27 Balance = \$36,483.85
- Allocated: \$35,030 to requests from staff.
- An additional \$1,600 from direct drive funding was allocated to requests that are considered not eligible for PAC funding and School will match that with \$1,600 in funding.
- General Account has \$1,022 balance.
- Direct Drive funds has a balance of \$3,175 and \$1,600 of that has been allocated to requests not eligible for gaming funds.

#### **3. Principal's Report - Kal Gill**

- We are well into semester one as we come up to finishing 2 months of the school year. Please continue to monitor how your child is doing in this new format. Most students should be getting **daily homework**.
- **Interim reports** containing a work habit and a comment were published on the My Education family portal on October 15<sup>th</sup>.



- The BC Shakeout earthquake drill was held on the afternoon of October 21<sup>st</sup>. The entire District participated in the drill, and it was an opportunity for the school to **review its emergency preparedness plan**.
- School was not in session for students on October 22<sup>nd</sup> as it was the Provincial Professional Development Day. Most of our staff were engaged in virtual conferences organized by their specialty teaching area associations.
- Thanks to PAC for once again receiving applications for gaming funds. The **deadline for staff to apply was October 15<sup>th</sup>**.
- The **Mini School Parent information night is being held on October 28<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm** in the auditorium. The Killarney Mini School is taking on a new direction. The Killarney Computer Science Mini School to start with its inaugural class in September 2022, is a Computer Science focused experience for highly motivated students. Students will experience an enriched math, science, and information technology curriculum (Grade 8-10) for the junior high school years, and then be able to focus on a specialty area for grades 10 – 12. The specialty areas include:
  - Programming (Machine Learning/Artificial Intelligence)
  - System Administrator
  - Network Administrator
  - Cyber Security
  - Robotics

District online registration for Mini Schools opens Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>, The mini school students in grades 9 and 10 will continue with the current model.

- The last day to purchase early bird pricing for the **Yearbook** (\$40) is October 29<sup>th</sup>. The price goes up to \$50 on November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- The first round of **Numeracy/Literacy assessments** will be happening in the week of November 1-5. Grade 10 students with PE in the first semester will do the Numeracy assessment on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Literacy assessment on November 5<sup>th</sup>. Students with PE in semester 2 will do their assessments in April.



- Grade 12 students also have to do the **Literacy 12 assessment**. Those students with English Studies 12 in the first semester will write the literacy assessment on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Students with English Studies 12 in semester 2 will write the Literacy assessment in April.
- The **Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12 assessments** are graduation requirements. Students receive a proficiency mark of 1-4 corresponding to the proficiency levels of beginning, developing, applying, and extending.
- The Senior Girls Volleyball team won the **Van Tech Tournament** last week.
